1. Minutes from Yorks were accepted with no comments

3. Decision: Next NKL network meeting will be 26-28 April (two of these days) 2017 in Norway, Fredrikstad. The NKL-members' travel costs (within reasonable limits, only public transportation, no taxi etc.) will be reimbursed, and we expect to also reimburse hotel for 2 nights at a chosen hotel in Fredrikstad. Reservations at this hotel will be done by the local organizers of the NKL-network meeting. The first day of the meeting will be a public conference presenting NKL-work and eventually DIPEX collaboration. The second day will be NKL-network meeting.
4. Information: Our COST Action application was not awarded, and next application deadline for COST Action is 7 December 2016, and then the next one approximately late summer or early autumn 2017. We decided to re-submit an improved application on December 7.
5. General discussion: How to push the network further (publications etc.), including the DIPEX collaboration, the in York planned NKL Book project, protocol for first empirical study?
6. COST Action application
 - a. Decision: change the COST application title to make it more precise: from "EnCIPHer – Knowledge, communication and personalised health: navigating the digital landscape" to (at least preliminary) „Persons-centred

approach on health related knowledge in the digital society“ or another suggestion “Searching for health related knowledge in the digital society”.

Observe: We now need a new acronym

- b. Before re-submission we will concentrate on simplifying the application, evaluate our choice of topic, contact additional stakeholders, patients organisations and software developers
 - c. Emilio, Srecko and Øystein will try to get patient organisations on board. Emilio will contact the IC-Health project and try to connect for the parts about communication
 - d. Theme to include in our work (in our discussions, articles, and application): Knowledge vs. Truth discussion
 - e. Discussion: how about products as outcome of the project? (This in addition to establishing a vocabulary that makes joint talk, discussions, and analysis on health in digital society possible): Our outcome could be software products. Thus we need more informatics specialist (ask Helena and Harald), Anna will send e-mails
 - f. Schedule for application work: Srecko is coming to Norway on 17th November und stays one week. Anna Lydia is going to Helena November 27-December 3.
 - g. Emilio will contact IAPO
 - h. Østein will contact some patient organisations in Norway
7. Book project: Srecko and Anna will discuss with Andrew Webster and Joachim Allgaier how to proceed with the book and how related to the meeting and conference in Fredrikstad
- Two different books are possible:
- a) systematic anthology with book chapters as discussed in York
 - b) a collection of articles in the Croatian medical journal (will be available anyway, Srecko)
