Abstracts for the symposium should all directly or indirectly concern our understanding of the digital society as a knowledge landscape to navigate matters to do with health and illness or be related to mining and representing perspectives of online health information.

We invite authors to particularly submit abstracts on:

- a. Conceptual/theoretical work that helps develop our key concepts of geographies and navigation in knowledge landscapes (NKL).
- b. Empirical work that analyses online health narratives, including content analysis of different (social) media platforms (YouTube videos, Facebook) and interactional approaches to online health talk.
- c. Current work or collaborations that foster discussion on particular methodological challenges and/or mixed methods approaches to the study of navigating knowledge landscapes (NKL);
- d. Abstracts that elaborate on relations between NKL-themes and person-centred care.
- e. Abstracts on governance, trust, safety, risk handling, knowledge and expertise, ethics in relation to navigating the digital society for health information.
- f. Abstracts on analysing language for identifying perspective.
- g. Abstracts on modelling perspectives and knowledge landscapes.
- h. Abstracts on algorithms, either as part of one of the themes above (a-g) or as a separate theme.
