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Part 1: In Spain, the government instructions about the use of masks have experienced

Copernican turn. On February 28, 2020, the Minister of Health declared in a television

interview, "masks are not necessary in Spain to go on the streets". The official information

provided on 2 April did not mention them². On 20 April, the Ministry of Health published

recommendations stating, "the use of masks in the community should be considered only as a

complementary measure"³. Finally, on May 12, the government raised the possibility of forcing

the population to use them.⁴

One of the main issues with the masks has been their availability. In February, the

population began to hoard them, which led to a shortage of supplies. The health care givers

have had to work in deplorable conditions due to the lack of adequate material.

The Spanish have followed the confinement instructions very strictly. The problem is that

the return to normality has not been combined with uniform measures on the use of masks.

Some regional governments already distribute them free of charge. Others do not. No one,

however, forces citizens to wear them. It is likely that we will soon see further changes.

Part 2: I am in support of the mandatory use of masks in public spaces. I believe it is the

only practicable and effective measure.

Part 3: At the beginning of the pandemic, the use of masks had political connotations:

since the government advised against their use, their wearing was even considered a form of

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political opinion.
