

**Invitation to the 3rd Navigating Knowledge Landscapes' PhD training event,
September, 19th, 2021.**

Innovative knowledge in the digital society

This PhD training is the third in a series of PhD training events. This year, it will be held on the 19th of September: the day before the annual NKL International Conference. The PhD training addresses the PhD students of the NKL network as well as the PhD students of NKL members. The PhD-training offers international networking with peers, to support the participants' current works as well as the transition to post-doc projects and positions. The participants will receive a certificate for their participation from the organizing university, this year Mid Sweden University. For the participation to be included in the official PhD training, it is up to each PhD student to negotiate this with their home university.

The PhD training event takes its point of departure from the PhD students' own projects.

The participants are expected to submit a short, one-page text to the tutors at latest one week prior to the event. This text should include information about themselves, their research projects (including empirical material, theories, methods and, if applicable, preliminary findings). These texts will be distributed to the group of PhD students as well as the tutors, to facilitate the discussions.

The PhD student is also expected to give a 10 minute presentation at the PhD training event. The focus of this presentation are questions that the PhD student finds particularly important to discuss. The presentation should be submitted to the organizer one week in advance to be distributed to one of the participating peers. During the PhD training event, The PhD students will be paired, and expected to prepare comments on one presentation, and after that, engage in a wider group discussion, moderated by a selected number of tutors, among them Franc Mali, University of Ljubljana, Jennie Olofsson, Mid Sweden University and Anna-Lydia Svalastog, Østfold University College and Uppsala University.

Ultimately, the PhD students, as a group, are expected to present a short report from, and reflections on the PhD training event at the NKL International Conference on September, the 20th (10-15 minutes).
